Physical or chemical hazards: Dry sodium chlorite is incompatible with acids, reducing agents, combustible materials, sulfur-containing rubbers, solvents and paints. Keep activated solution from light and heat. If activated solution is not used, immediately open container in well-ventilated area. Store below 120°F, away from water and acids, and out of direct sunlight.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

1. Open front door panel of ice machine.
2. Remove and discard spent CleanAir packet, if present.
3. Open the foil package, ensuring envelope (CleanAir packet) inside is not cut. Discard desiccants.
4. Place CleanAir packet inside of plastic holder inside of ice machine.
5. Moisture within the food zone of the ice machine will naturally activate the CleanAir packet.
6. Close the front door of the ice machine.
7. Replace CleanAir packet every 30 days.

FIRST AID

If in Eyes: Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after rinsing. If activated solution is in eye, call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If on Skin or Clothing: Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If swallowed: Call poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting. If person is unconscious, call a poison control center or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.

If Inhaled: Remove victim to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible.

Call a poison control center or doctor for more information. Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

Note to Physicians: Probable mucosal damage may contraindicate the use of gastric lavage.
